

Cost Breakdowns for MCC Giving Projects 2019

What can your donations do? The following examples represent current MCC projects; exact costs vary by location and other factors. Costs are listed in Canadian dollars.

Food

- \$13** covers the cost of planting and nurturing a fruit tree in Bangladesh.
- \$30** provides vaccinations for a flock of 25 chickens in Bangladesh.
- \$80** provides materials for one community group (25 people) to save crop seeds in Bangladesh.
- \$60** provides one goat in Haiti (and many other countries where MCC provides goats).
- \$15** provides 10 chicks in India.
- \$100** covers the cost for a veterinarian to travel to remote villages in India.
- \$100** provides conservation agricultural training for one young farmer in Lesotho.
- \$125** provides beekeeping supplies for a family in Iraq.

Water

- \$450** provides one rainwater catchment system in Bolivia.
- \$20** provides training for one water management committee in Ethiopia.
- \$1,500** provides hygiene and sanitation education for an entire neighborhood in Ethiopia.
- \$4,500** builds one complete well in Ethiopia.
- \$100** provides two water filters needed for one well in Mozambique.
- \$750** provides a pump in one well in Mozambique.
- \$5,200** builds one complete well in Mozambique.
- \$725** provides one ventilated, improved pit latrine in Nigeria.
- \$22** provides one handwashing station near a pit latrine in Nigeria.
- \$5,200** builds one borehole well in Nigeria.
- \$120** connects a home to safe water in Lebanon.

Education and Training

- \$15** provides school supplies for one child in many countries where MCC provides school kits.
- \$75** provides after school tutoring in Guatemala.
- \$100** helps girls attend school in Bangladesh.
- \$525** provides tuition for one refugee child living in Lebanon.
- \$300** provides one sewing machine to a new tailor in South Sudan.
- \$150** provides needed fabrics for one participant's training in South Sudan.
- \$300** provides needed sewing supplies for one participant in South Sudan.
- \$270** provides vocational training for one young adult in Rwanda.



Relief

\$40 provides items for one relief kit: (bath soap, shampoo, laundry soap, toothbrushes, bath towels, combs, fingernail clipper, band-aids, sanitary pads).

\$400 covers the customs fees for one shipment to Syria.

\$100 provides food and comfort for a family in need in Ukraine.

\$8,300 is the average cost to ship a container of humanitarian aid to Ukraine.

\$25 provides one set of farming tools (hoe, machete and axe) for people displaced by violence in DR Congo.

\$80 provides one sow for a family displaced by violence in DR Congo.

\$260 builds one piggery to house pigs for a family displaced by violence in DR Congo.

\$115 provides one month of meals for a Venezuelan refugee in Colombia.

\$1,300 covers the weekly cost of meals for 45 Venezuelan refugees, provided by the Mennonite Church of Riohacha, Colombia.

How many items from MCC fit into a shipping container?

1 container of canned meat = 1,000 cartons = 24,000 cans

1 container of relief kits = approximately 2,100 kits

1 container of school kits = approximately 15,000 kits

Peace and Justice

\$30 provides support to a new peace club member in Nigeria (and in other countries where MCC supports peace clubs).

\$70 provides training and support for one conflict prevention volunteer in Nigeria.

\$100 covers the cost of one person to attend a peace camp in Laos.

\$100 supports peace training for police officers in Uganda.

Health

\$300 provides a water tank and pumps for one school in Jordan.

\$330 pays local workers to construct a school garden in Jordan.

\$530 provides water piping for one school in Jordan.

\$10 provides a carton of thrive formula for babies whose mothers have HIV in Nigeria.

\$70 provides HIV test kits and accessories in Nigeria.

\$6 provides hygiene supplies to help keep a girl in school in Burundi.

\$65 provides a take-home soap for 50 students in Burundi.

\$100 provides soap for every classroom at Hope School in Burundi.

\$14,500 is the average cost to ship a container of MCC canned meat to Burundi (24,000 cans).
