

Cost Breakdowns for MCC Projects

2020

What can your donations do? This list provides examples of what can be accomplished through small and large donations and everything in between. These are representative of more than 600 projects supported by MCC, and exact costs vary by location and other factors. Costs are listed in Canadian dollars.

Food

- \$13** provides drought-tolerant seeds in Kenya.
- \$15** provides chicks for a family in Bangladesh.
- \$23** stocks one family's pond with fish fingerlings in Cambodia.
- \$33** provides vaccinations for a flock of 25 chickens in Bangladesh.
- \$54** provides nutrition training and kitchen garden seeds for 10 families in Nepal.
- \$80** provides materials to save crop seeds for a community group of 25 people in Bangladesh.
- \$195** provides lunch for one child throughout the school year in Ethiopia.
- \$200** helps a farmer in Colombia learn to grow and market cacao, which is made into chocolate.
- \$1,040** covers the cost of goat-raising workshops for 80 families in Lebanon.

Water

- \$40** provides 10 metres of durable pipe to help bring spring water to a village in India.
- \$23,000** builds one complete spring-water system for a village in India.
- \$175** provides a carbon water filter for one school in Nicaragua.
- \$100** provides two water filters needed for one well in Mozambique.
- \$780** provides a pump in one well in Mozambique.
- \$5,200** digs one complete well in Mozambique.

Education and Training

- \$33** provides hot, nutritious breakfasts for one student throughout the year in Cambodia.
- \$40** provides nine months of pastry training for one woman in Bolivia.
- \$75** provides school supplies for 10 children in many countries where MCC provides school kits.
- \$168** covers one student's tuition fees in Syria.
- \$260** provides vocational training for one young adult in Rwanda.
- \$280** provides a reading toolkit for a primary school classroom in Cambodia.
- \$520** provides tuition for one refugee child living in Lebanon.



Relief

\$40 provides items for one relief kit: (bath soap, shampoo, laundry soap, toothbrushes, bath towels, combs, fingernail clipper, band-aids, sanitary pads).

\$400 covers the customs fees for one shipment to Syria.

\$100 provides food and comfort for a family in need in Ukraine.

\$80 provides one sow for a family displaced by violence in DR Congo.

\$260 builds one piggery to house pigs for a family displaced by violence in DR Congo.

\$110 provides one month of meals for a Venezuelan refugee in Colombia.

\$1,270 covers the weekly cost of meals for 45 Venezuelan refugees, provided by the Mennonite Church of Riohacha, Colombia.

How many items from MCC fit into a shipping container?

1 container of canned meat = 1,000 cartons = 24,000 cans

1 container of relief kits = approximately 2,100 kits

1 container of school kits = approximately 15,000 kits

Peace and Justice

\$26 provides peace training for a pastor in Ethiopia.

\$25 helps a refugee family resettle in Canada.

\$30 provides training for a new peace club member in Nigeria (and in other countries where MCC supports peace clubs).

\$75 supports peace training for police officers in Uganda.

\$150 provides trauma healing for children in South Sudan (and other war-affected countries).

Health

\$300 provides a water tank and pumps for one school in Jordan.

\$20 provides hygiene supplies to help keep a girl in school in Burundi.

\$65 provides a take-home soap for 50 students in Burundi.

\$100 provides soap for every classroom at Hope School in Burundi.

\$22 provides one water filtration bucket in North Korea. (These are used in a patient's hospital room and then families can take them home when the child is discharged.)

\$45 provides one large bottle of multivitamins in North Korea (around 1,400 doses).
