

Refugee Sponsorship application process

- 1) Send email to refugeesponsorship@mccab.ca in December 2021 providing answers to **ALL** of the following questions
 - a. Describe the family (ie. Size, ages, roles, etc.)
 - b. What country are they from (birth country)?
 - i. Why did they flee?
 - c. What country are they in currently (Country of asylum/residence)?
 - i. Why can't they stay there?
 - ii. What is their immigration status?
 - iii. Are they registered with the local government and/or the UNHCR?
 1. Are they *recognized* as refugees?
 - d. Do you have a group of 5 or more people able to support in the emotional, cultural, logistical resettlement of this family?
 - e. Does your group have sufficient resources to support this family according to the cost table below?

- a. Highlight any additional vulnerabilities this family is facing.
 - i. Examples include but are not limited to:
 1. Vulnerable woman/girls
 2. Single parent
 3. Physical and/or mental health concerns
 4. Elderly
 5. Survivor of torture and trauma
 6. At imminent risk of being subjected to torture or trauma
 7. At imminent risk of deportation
 8. At imminent risk of imprisonment
 9. At imminent risk of death
- 2) In January 2022, MCC will go through the applications received and prioritize those most in need
- 3) In February 2022, MCC and all other SAH's receive their allocation from the Government of Canada at which time MCC can decide who will be selected
 - a. An email with a decision will be sent to all who I have received a request from. This will likely come in late February or early March.
- 4) I am happy to answer any question you or your group may have throughout the application process related specifically to your sponsorship or other questions you may have regarding refugee resettlement.
