NEW FOOD SOURCES FOR FAMILIES Cambodia

Your gift will help families in Prey Veng Province, Cambodia, boost their nutrition and incomes. Each family receives training and supplies so they can start a household garden and raise chickens and fish. With your support, parents can grow healthy food at home and earn money for expenses like school fees and medical care for their children.

WATER AT SCHOOL

Nicaragua

HELP DIG A WELL

Mozambique

Join MCC and the Christian Council of Mozambique to provide wells in the Caia and Marromeu districts, where the search for clean and reliable water is urgent. Your gift will help to dig new borehole wells and repair existing wells as needed. Each well provides clean water for an average of 300 people, and local committees are trained on well maintenance.

PIPE SPRING WATER TO A VILLAGE

India

Spring-water projects use gravity to bring water from natural streams at higher levels to the villages below. Using a system of pipes and catchment chambers, water is diverted at the village level to ensure everyone has access. Families use this water for irrigation, bathing, washing dishes and laundry. Your gift will help to install or improve a system like this in Odisha, India. Each system provides water for 250 or more people.

Pictured, Tribeni Nayak is enjoying piped water for the first time in her life in Bastriguda village, India. She says, "I used to walk for two to two and a half kilometers to fetch water. Now I can access it very near from my backyard garden. Mustard, cauliflower, tomato, beans, carrots, radishes, are sprouting for the first time in backyard gardens in my village." 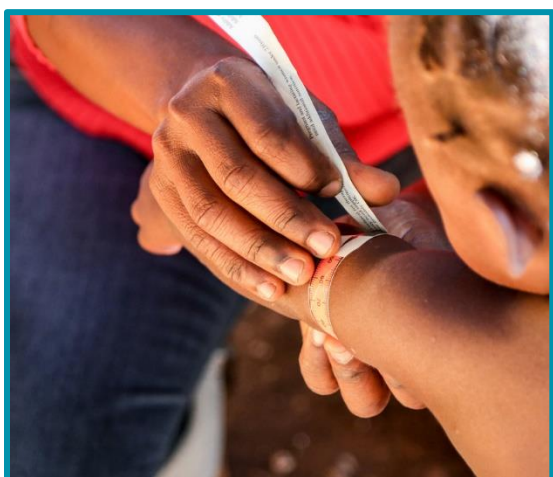

NUTRITION FOR YOUNG CHILDREN

Haiti

Help young children like Gabina Ossinel (pictured) grow healthy and strong through your donation. In Haiti your gift will help to fund mobile clinics working to fight the problem of malnutrition in six mountain communities. Children ages 6 months through 5 years receive check-ups and nutritional supplements as needed. Parents learn what they can do to improve their family's nutrition and health.
