Residential School Video Tour - Virtual Tour (Zoom)	Debrief Q&A	Residential School Presentation
<p><i>\$250.00 for Schools \$350.00 for Businesses</i></p> <p>The Residential School Virtual Tour is normally offered on the grounds of Woodland Cultural Centre only; however, given the ongoing restrictions pertaining to Covid-19, in the interest of public safety while also acknowledging the need for continued education, the Woodland Cultural Centre board of directors has approved the video being shown through Zoom meetings. These sessions are not to be recorded, are password protected, and will be limited to a maxium of 40 guests.</p> <p>The virtual tour video was created with local production company Thru the Reddoor, and it follows the guide, Lorrie Gallant, as she gives a tour of the former Mohawk Institute Indian Residential School. During the video Lorrie provides the history of the institution over its 140 year history. Viewers will get to see the different rooms in the school, from the girls' and boys' dormitories, the cafeteria, laundry room, and other rooms throughout the building, as well as hear interviews from five Survivors of the Mohawk Institute.</p> <p>1 hour Gr 6+</p> <p>(*Note: Students should have previous knowledge of the history of Residential Schools.)</p>	<p><i>\$50.00</i></p> <p>Save the Evidence Coordinator, Carley Gallant-Jenkins, will be available from 30 minutes to 1 hour after viewing the Virtual Tour to answer questions in response to the video, and other questions you may have pertaining to the lasting impacts of Residential School. Q+A content is meant to invoke further thought, but must stay rooted in respect and privacy. As all Q+A sessions are unique to the questions provided by each group, there will not be any slides or notes further to the discussion shared outside the limits of the Zoom session.</p> <p>Woodland Cultural Centre recommends pre-selecting a moderator to review questions that guests may have prior to watching the video. 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Payment:

Payment for your selected programming **must be received prior to facilitation**. During this time of physical distancing, Woodland Cultural Centre is currently only able to accept the following three (3) forms of payment. Please highlight your preferred payment method.

Cancellation Notice:

The Woodland Cultural Centre requires a 2-week advance notice of cancellation or postponement for a tour. The 2-week time period is in calendar days (not business days). Failure to provide notice of cancellation or postponement will result in the assessment of a cancellation fee. The Board of Governors of the Woodland Cultural Centre has set the cancellation fee at \$200.00. Failure to remit payment of this fee will affect a group's / organizations's ability to book further tours and programming of the Woodland Cultural Centre.

Changing of Numbers:

Woodland Cultural Centre requires two weeks notice to any change in numbers; this is to ensure that the maximum participants are not overbooked. A final count of the number of participants will be conducted by your program facilitator on the day of your selected programming.

Other:

- All fees are a flat rate, regardless of group size.
- Woodland Cultural Centre does not charge tax on programming.
- The maximum total group size is 40 guests (students, teachers, adults combined).
- Specialized programming subject to increased fee for services.
